We are currently looking for two people whose main duties would be to remove invasive exotic species such as bush honeysuckle. This position is a great opportunity for those wanting to gain experience in the field of conservation.

Job duties

- Majority of time will be spent controlling exotic species with the use of hand tools, power tools, and herbicide
- Trail maintenance
- Assisting naturalist in leading interpretive walks on preserve
- Marking preserve boundaries
- Participating in natural resource inventory and monitoring (macroinvertebrates, plants, animals)
- Working with volunteers
- General equipment maintenance
- Record keeping of time spent on preserve

Job requirements

- Ability to work outside in a variety of conditions
- Ability to work without supervision
- Plant I.D. skills preferred, but will train
- Ability to work 20 hours a week – this is flexible
