Registration Information:

Cost: Workshop fees will cover a book or relevant resource chosen by the instructors and allow us to purchase materials that will be used by the participants.

Cancellations: Workshop fee is refundable up to three weeks prior to workshop.

Registration: Workshops are limited to 12-16 participants. There will be no exceptions. Early registration is encouraged to reserve a spot. If a workshop is full when you register, you will be put on a waiting list in case of a cancellation.

Location: All workshops will begin at the Winifred W. Haggart Nature Center at Floracliff Nature Sanctuary. Directions will be sent with registration confirmation.

Expectations: Participants should be able to handle moderate hiking on uneven terrain. Please be prepared for the weather forecast for each workshop. Hiking sticks, extra water, hiking boots, and rain gear are strongly encouraged. Participants are responsible for bringing their own lunch.

Workshop Specific Information:

Mushrooms: Participants are encouraged to bring a peck basket, knife, wax bags or wax paper. Folks can also bring mushrooms in good condition for identification.

Stream Bio-monitoring: Participants are required to bring wading boots (non-slip soles) and wading socks (neoprene).

Conifers: Participants are encouraged to bring a hand lens (10x).
